

# 'There is no end to the rocket fire'

**Moyal met Wednesday with Deputy Defense Minister Matan Vilna'i, OC Southern Command Maj.-Gen. Yoav Galant and United Nations Special Coordinator Robert H. Serry.**

**Serry, who visited Gaza on Tuesday, told reporters Wednesday he had wanted to see the situation in Sderot for himself. "I wanted to come to show my solidarity for the people living in this Israeli town," he said.**

**He visited the police station, where he saw the collection of rusted rockets that is stacked behind the building. Serry said the rocket launches constituted "random terror attacks."**

**"They must stop," he said, calling for a cease-fire.**

**During his visit to the Strip, he said, he told people that the majority of Gazans were paying the price for the actions of a small minority who were firing rockets.**

**"I'm alarmed by the escalation of the attacks," he said Wednesday, adding that the UN was deeply concerned by the escalation in violence.**

**He said that UN was helping with its efforts to feed the people in Gaza, where four out of five people were dependent on food staples provided by the organization.**
